The show, which premiered on January 17, 2012 (when the channel was called Spike), features tattoo artists competing with various challenges in evaluating their tattoo and other related art skills. They are valued by famous tattoo artists and enthusiasts, with one or more contestants being eliminated in each episode. The last contestant standing each season receives a \$100,000 prize, titled Ink Master and Feature Inked Magazine. The series is produced by Original Media, which also produces the reality show Miami Ink. Three divestiture broadcasts entitled Ink Master: Redemption, Ink Master: Angels and Ink Master: Grudge Match,[1][2] have also been released. [3] The series has also released several special standalone episodes usually themed around an upcoming event or holiday like Halloween. Season Ten (titled Ink Master: Masters Return) premiered on January 9, 2018, and aired its first two episodes of Spike before the network rebranded as the Paramount Network. On April 24, 2018, it was announced that Paramount Network had renewed the series for the eleventh season. [4] Twelfth Season titled Ink Master: Fighting For Sex, premiere on June 11, 2019. On November 12, 2019, it was announced that the thirteenth season, titled Ink Master: Turf War, will premiere on January 7, 2020. [5] On January 9, 2020, after several Photos of MySpace, updated from the internet featuring Oliver Peck sporting blackface, and a costume with a large N chest, the Ink Master announced that he would no longer be associated with the show. [6] On September 22, 2020, the Paramount Network canceled the series as part of the network's transition to films. [7] On December 1, 2020, the first two seasons were available for release on Netflix in the United States. [8] International broadcasts Ink Master airs on the Australian TV channel, 7mate. In the UK The Ink Master airs on truTV, also available in Ireland. In the Netherlands and Flanders, both the Ink master and their Dutch-speaking adaptations of the Ink Master: Meesters van de Lage Landen (Ink Master: from low lands) is aired on Spike in the Netherlands. Show format Basic format All episodes aside from the finals have the following format, with some minor variations to apply the format: First, there is a Flash Challenge that will be evaluated based on how well the artist met skills during the week. Some Flash Challenges include tattooing, but usually, flash problems don't include the act of tattooing; but will instead require unrelated artistic skills (i.e. dyeing, hair cutting, coding, burning, etc.). The winner of the flash challenge wins the right to choose his man's canvas with the elimination challenge, and, as of the second season, a couple of other contestants with their human canvases. After the Flash Challenge comes the Elimination Challenge, an additional test of the skill of the weekly human canvases, usually involves a remarkable style of tattooing. When the contestants are paired with their canvases, they are given a day to consult with their assignment. The next day, each contestant is given four to six hours to tattoo their own design. Once completed, the contestants meet as a group with the judges and are criticized one by one. The contestants are then rejected, with four later called back. The four usually represent the top two and the bottom two a week, although this distribution may change. At the end of each episode, the winner is usually announced, and one contestant is eliminated. Special format for the first season finale, the last challenge was marathon tattooing up to 18 hours. The season two finale did not share this format, and instead consisted of each of the three finalists meeting with their respective canvases for four six-hour sessions to create the final piece. This last piece did not require a special tattoo of the genre or location of the artist tattoo. Instead, artists were able to choose these aspects for themselves, and the only limitation they faced was maturity. The season three finale was followed by a similar format to the season two finale, but artists were allowed five seven-hour sessions for a cumulative 35-hour master canvas tattoo. Judging Musician Dave Navarro and tattoo artists Chris Núñez and Oliver Peck served as the show's primary judges. [9] Navarro and Núñez appeared in each episode, but Peck did for two episodes in season nine as he recovered from a heart attack. [10] Some episodes include a fourth guest judge, usually a well-known tattoo artist who has knowledge or reputation in the style of tattoo (such as New School, Traditional, Japanese, Portrait, Black and Gray, etc.), selected for the week's elimination challenge. Season two judging was taken to a new level with audience voting participation via the series' official website, as well as through Facebook voting, with the audience vote affecting the final ruling judges. Sebastian Murphy was ruled out of consideration by the judges in the season finale because he was whose work elimination problems received the least votes in the audience. Season three presented a human canvas jury in which human canvases revisit each other's tattoos and nominate the elimination of the artist who did the worst piece. Season four presented a defeat challenge to the winner's choice, where the challenge winner cuts the artist's elimination. Oliver Peck was forced out of his seat as an Ink Master Judge after a controversy involving his re-blackface photo from his MySpace page. Judging by the photos, this event would most likely have happened more than a decade ago when he was married to Kat Von D.[6] Before the series was officially canceled, there was no word on the replacement. Three finalists (Bob Jones, Angel Rose and Jimmy Snez) were awarded a prize money, but none of them were named in the Ink Master. Specials There have been various standalone holiday and special event themed episodes that don't follow the series seasons. They are usually after an upcoming or recently passed holiday. These episodes feature previous Ink Master contestants competing for less prize money. [13] Ink Master licensed Dutch/Belgian edition entitled Ink Master: Meesters van de Landen (Master of Low States) in 2017. The format remains largely intact, filming takes place mostly around Amsterdam. The winner of the first season of this edition was Belgian rival Generous. The second season takes place in IJmuiden and was won by Belgian rival Joyce. Spin offs Ink Master: Redemption Spin-off series Ink Master: Redemption premiere in September 2015. [14] [15] Spin-off features canvases that are frustrated with the tattoo they received during the competition. After consulting with his tattoo with Navarro, the canvases are given the opportunity to confront the artist who did the original piece. The artist is offered the option of redemption, with it can be consulted with the canvases for a new tattoo (or modifications to enhance your existing Ink Master piece). After reviewing the artist's new drawing, the canvases is given no-strings of added choice to either continue with the new tattoo or leave the store. Episodes sometimes feature a twist, such as rival artists returning to draw the design of the same hapless canvases, perhaps stealing the original artist's chance of redemption. Ink Master: Redemption was renewed for a second season to coincide with the premiere of season 7 of Ink Master. [16] Ink Master: Angelic Master: Ink Master: Angels In June 2017 Spike announced a new cut from a series called Inkmaker: Angels. The premise follows four women in the race from the eighth season of The Ink Master – season winner Ryan Ashley Malarkey, Kelly Doty, Nikki Simpson and Gia Rose – as they travel across the United States to deal with other artists tattoo problems with a spot on the season ten Master Ink on the line. [17] The show premiered on October 3, 2017. Ink Master: Grudge Match was announced on August 21, 2019, that the premiere will be released on October 1, 2019. [2] [3] Kanāls satur sporta un programmes primāri aimed at male audiences[4] with programming designed to new shows. American network shows and other shows previously aired on its sister channels Seven, 7two and 7flix. [2] On 10 May 2016, 7HD rebroadcast led to a 7mate reduction to the standard definition broadcast in Melbourne and Adelaide. Instead, Sydney, Brisbane and Perth received HD simulcast from 7mate by December 2016[6][6] with a breakout program used from this point to broadcast AFL games in HD, keeping 7HD as the primary channel simulcast. [8] History Channel began to air as a separate channel on September 25, 2010, replacing 7HD as the seven network's only high-definition channel. [2] [9] The channel's first programme was the 2010 AFL Grand Final, which was simulcast with an SD broadcast on the Seven Network. After the AFL coverage, the channel began pea breakout programming, with an ad sneak peek of the upcoming program on 7mate. The first full program to air was an episode of that '70s Show. After the 7HD was reborn on 10 May 2016, 7mate was reduced to the standard definition. 7HD became the HD simulcast's seven main channel in Melbourne and Adelaide, but it simulcast 7mate in Seven other metropolitan markets. This configuration allowed upcoming AFL matches to be broadcast in HD format in all markets. [5] [6] The 7HD was temporarily changed to the seven main channel simulations in Sydney, Brisbane and Perth on 5 August 2016, so that the 2016 Summer Olympics can be broadcast at high-definition games in all capital cities; 7mate only in the standard definition. However, 7HD was returned to its former state as a 7mate simulcast in Sydney, Brisbane and Perth on 22 August 2016 after the Olympic games were concluded. [10] On 16 December 2016, 7HD was transferred to seven major channels in Sydney, Brisbane and Perth to broadcast tennis on a high-definition channel in all capital cities; leaving a 7mate SD. [7] These changes were not reverted, with seven instead using a breakout program in 7HD to broadcast AFL matches in 7mate HD. [8] In October 2019, Seven promised 7mate will switch to HD by 2020[11] It was later revealed on 29 December 2019 that as of 16 January 2020, the 7 food network would replace the 7 food network. On July 10, 2020, 7mate first unveiled its new logo in 2010, effectively making it in line with the Seven and 7s, which used only one color in both windows. The presentation of the logo was removed and the word mate is now in a different font. Programming Channel has targeted a demographic of 16- to 49-year-old men, following the success of the Seven Network with 7two with women 35+ and 25+ demographics respectively. The program aired on the channel's blend of re-shows that moved from Seven Network or 7two, a program that would make it a free-to-air debut and a brand new show on Australian television. Seven and 7TWO now target its 55+ demographic. Shows that moved from other Seven channels include a new season of Family Guy, Dad! and Amazing Race. The re-season scrubs, Last Comic Standing, Air Crash Investigation, 30 Rock, The '70s Show, Lost and How I Met Your Mother also moved to 7mate. Mighty Ships, of which three episodes aired as one-off specials on the Seven Network, moved as a regular series 7mate. In 2012, the Seven Network introduced a new weekday morning blocks for children planning in the air for both 7two and 7mate. Branded as K-Zone, the 7mate block featured men skewing Disney series such as Phineas and Ferb, Kick Buttowski: Suburban Dare, a couple of Kings and Zeke and Luther, while a two block aired women's skewing programs branded as Total Girl. [12] Programs that make their free-to-air debut include Eastbound and Down, Monster Garage, Jersey Shore, Gene Simmons Family Jewels and Punk'd. A brand new series includes Equalizer, Warehouse 13 and Caprica. In addition, the channel will feature several sporting events. [13] As of 2012, all AFL broadcasts live in 700 new wales, Australia and Queensland, On February 29, 2016, 7mate removes all children's programs and moves to another digital channel 7flix, and this channel replaces lifestyle fishing shows. 7mate local production Bogan Hunters premiered the channel's highest ratings non-sports program on 7mate. On May 13, 2014. [15] On February 28, 2018, 7mate started to sow The Simpsons every Wednesday night, ending the Network Ten after 27 years as part of a deal with Fox Corporation. Futurama was also added to 7mate in 2019, returning to the Seven Network as part of a deal with FOX and after a very, very long absence since its final broadcast in 2004. News 7mate airs Seven News updates that air on the main Seven channel and from 7TWO. All national news updates are all over any country. Sports 7mate televises live AFL coverage into New South Wales and Queensland, where rugby league is a more dominant sport, and Western Australia, due to the time difference. Some games can be televised after midnight, or not seen at all, because the current AFL contract requires local teams (i.e. Sydney Swans/Greater Western Sydney Giants, Brisbane Lions/Gold Coast Suns and West Coast Eagles/Fremantle Dockers) to be televised live (or, if Western Australia, for a three-hour delay) in their respective states. 7mate is also the exclusive broadcaster of the International Rules series for Australian audiences. [17] Previously, before 2012, the occasional Supercars championship aired on 7mate when there were AFL games that were broadcast at the same time. 7mate also televises some AFL matches live in Sydney and Brisbane, no matter which teams play. The 7mate also only broadcast all games of the 2013 Rugby League World Cup. [18] In November 2013, it was announced that 7mate had taken the right to broadcast the 2014 Hopman Cup after Network Ten decided to terminate its association with the event after three editions. The 7mate will broadcast South Australian National Football League matches from 2014 as part of the Seven Network's three-year deal to only broadcast the SANFL. After being with ABC since 1993, it marks the league's return to commercial television for the first time in 22 years. On June 15, 2014, Reggie Bush announced at sunrise that The Seven Network had agreed to a five-year deal to broadcast the NFL. Since 2015, 7mate has been used to continue deep sports coverage when the main Seven Channel breaks in its nightly news bulletin, such as australian open tennis (until 2018) or cricket (from 2019). In August 2016, 7mate broadcasts the 2016 Summer Olympics from Rio de Janeiro. In April 2018, 7mate broadcasts the 2018 Commonwealth Games from the Gold Coast. 7mate is the new free-to-air home of cricket in Australia along with Foxtel. It ended Nine's famous 45-year run as an exclusive Cricket broadcaster, and also ended Ten's famous 5-year run as an exclusive Big Bash League broadcaster. The network televises all men's international test matches, 43 Big Bash League matches, all women's internationals and 23 Women's Big Bash League matches. The six-year deal starts in 2018/2019 and runs until 2023/24. Availability of 7mate is available in standard definition metropolitan areas through the Seven Network owned and operated stations: ATN Sydney, HSV Melbourne, BTC Brisbane, SAS Adelaide and TVW Perth. In addition, in Sydney, Brisbane and Perth, 7mate is simulcast high using breakout planning for the AFL on 7HD. Seven-owned STQ Queensland is still broadcasting 7mate HD just because it doesn't carry 7HD. Regional affiliates continue to broadcast 7mate as a standalone multichannel in high definition; GWN7 regions and remote areas of Western Australia, where 7mate is broadcast in logical channel number 63. Prime7 in most regional areas of NSW/ACT, Victoria and the Gold Coast region of Queensland has broadcast 7mate standard definition channel 63 since launching Prime7 HD channel 60. Southern Cross Television also broadcasts a 7mate standard definition via GTS/BKN Spencer Gulf/Broken Hill on Channel 63, TNT Tasmania and TND Darwin on Channel 73 since launching Southern Cross HD on channels 60 and 70 respectively. The 7mate HD full-time high-definition simulcast 7mate was launched on 16 January 2020. The service broadcasts 1080i HD MPEG-4 format to digital channel 74, replacing the previously closed 7food network. The channel is available at Seven Network owned and operated stations at ATN Sydney, HSV Melbourne, BTQ Brisbane, SAS Adelaide, TVW Perth and STQ Queensland. Logo and identity history 2010.
